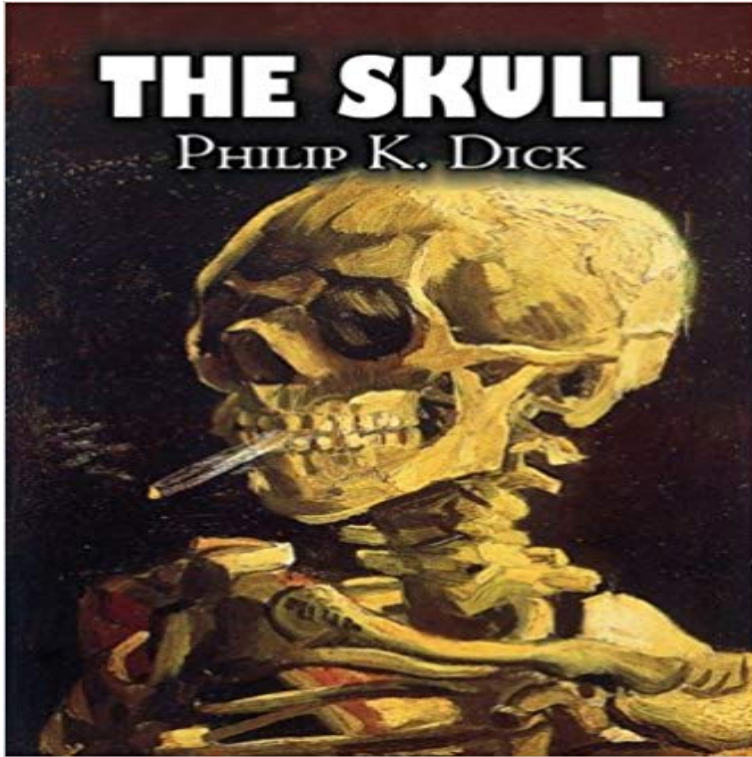


The Skull
