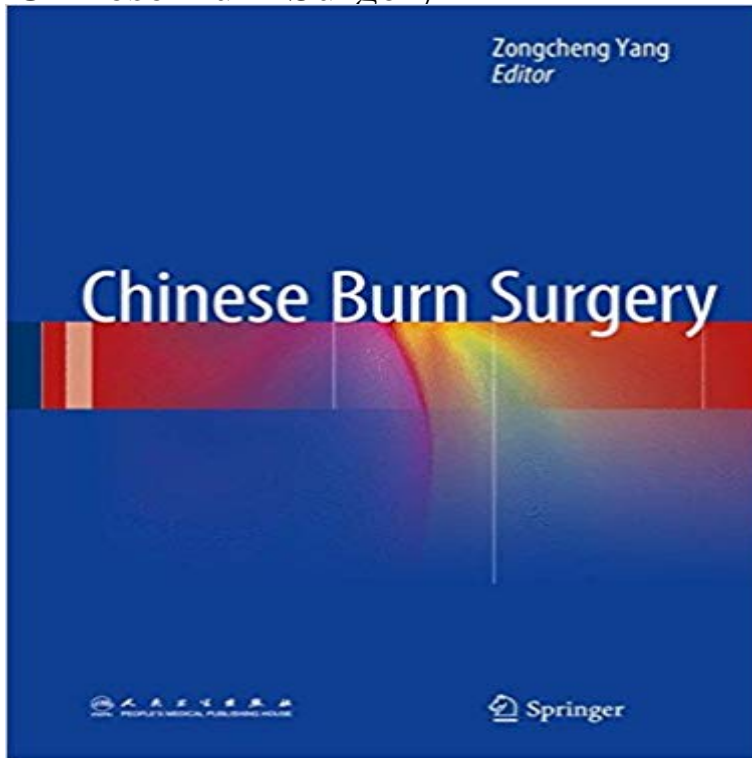


Chinese Burn Surgery
