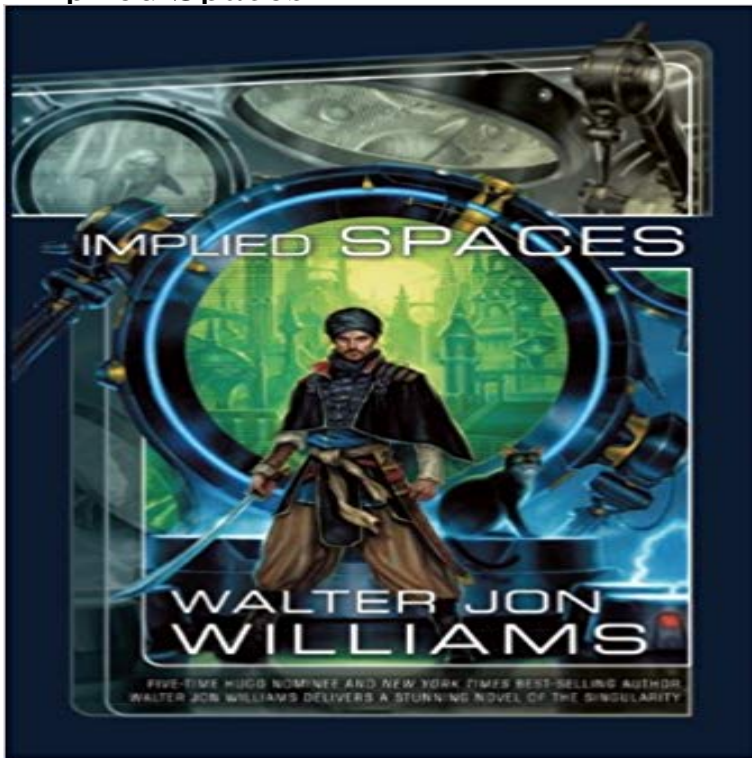


Implied Spaces
